CONTROLLED BURNS

When a Fire Chief has given permission to an individual to burn, he will instruct the individual to call the Communications Center, on the non-emergency number, before the burning is started. The Communications Center will obtain the exact location of the burning, the caller's name and phone number. The caller will also be instructed to call back when the burning is completed. The Fire Chief may also call the communications center himself and report that permission has been given for a controlled burn. If a fire company will be conducting a controlled burning, the O.I.C. should advise the Communications Center, by phone, before it is started.
