The Clearfield County Department of Emergency Management considers Hazmat response to be based on the NIMS.

Anytime a hazmat response or incident is occurring within Clearfield County, the local fire department will be notified.

In some instances, a cleanup company is dispatched directly by the trucking company involved and no emergency help is requested. When this occurs, the cleanup company must notify County EMA as soon as possible. When this occurs, the local Fire Chief or designee and local EMA will be notified.

When an in progress incident is reported via emergency communications, a response box will be alerted by 9-1-1, to include local EMA, county EMA, and the local fire company.
