FIRE DISPATCH MDC SECURITY

Clearfield County has installed a secure MDC signaling system. Any radio not authorized through Clearfield County Department of Emergency Management will be unable to communicate on the Clearfield County Fire Dispatch Frequency or with other Clearfield County authorized radios on the Fire Dispatch Frequency.

In order to be an authorized user, the radio must conform to an ID listed in SOP # 7-24. A Department/Company must complete and submit a Request for Radio Call Sign form (See SOP # 7-25). Please note that these identifiers are for the sole purpose of identifying the radio. Clearfield County will continue to use the current system when identifying apparatus and officers over the fire dispatch system (i.e. engine, tanker, rescue, utility, chief, etc).

Clearfield County Department of Emergency Management reserves the right to approve or deny any request for a radio call sign. Said Department reserves the right to disable any radio/user that fails to comply with Clearfield County Emergency Management Standard Operating Procedures and/or misuses the Fire Dispatch System in any way as deemed by management personnel.

Any radio to be found programmed without the expressed written consent of Clearfield County Department of Emergency Management, is subject to legal ramifications.
