Fire Police

The Clearfield County Department of Emergency Management has the following policy for Fire Police.

A Traffic Control incident has been created in CAD. Anytime there is a request for fire police, this incident code must be used. You will not receive recommendations for units, but you will notice a red box on the incident screen. By double clicking on this box, you will receive a window pop with specific instructions for fire police paging for every company. Please follow these instructions.

Paging will be the same as for fire companies. You will pre alert, if a tone is requested, you will alert it and then announce as if for a fire response.

With Fire Police having different needs for all companies, this action is necessary to make fire police dispatch more effective.
